1. Motion by Coy to Approve Minutes of Jan. 10, 2022 Council Meeting Minutes, 2nd by Nathan; Votes: Coy- Yes Nathan- Yes Chad-Yes

3. George Kern gave Financial Report and shared that the budget is looking good. Coy shared that the town is looking at hiring a realtor to give us market value for the donut shop with and without the back lot, since the town has been approached about buying the property. Motion by Coy to Approve Financial Report given by George M. Kern C.P.A., 2nd by Nathan; Coy – Yes Nathan – Yes Chad - Yes
4. Kellye Lea Graham and Peggy Sue Hutchison (record title owners) of property abandoned by the railroad which reverted to the Town of Savanna shared with council the map showing property and presented the deed to put property in their name. 5. Coy shared with council the town was approved for ARPA Grant for \$112,000. Savanna is on the list to receive the funds in two payments. No Action
6. Coy read Police Financial Report. David shared both K9s have completed their training and are National Recognized. Choctaw Nation is still planning to build 10 more houses but are running into problems with environmental

group. The asst. Chief for the tribe is talking about over ruling these problems so they can move forward with the project. The town has order heaters for the park restrooms so they can be used during the winter months and for heaters and labor is should cost around 1700.00. PD has received new units but waiting to outfit them with equipment and decals. No Action Needed

7. Fire Chief Jeff Jones shared Siren is still in Transit due to a part being on backorder, but hoping to have it on March 3rd along with Electric ran to pole. Jeff shared that Kiowa is have trouble with their Fire Dept. only having 4 members and talk of them quitting. Savanna has helped and will continue to do but if Savanna has to be the main Fire dept then we will charge Kiowa for the services. Savanna council will assist Kiowa council in moving the town forward but will not do it for them. No Action Needed
