- 3. Nick gave Financial Report and shared that the budget is looking good, but Police is a little out due to the big invoice from outfitting new units. Town is doing better than what was budgeted though, so we are doing well. Motion by Coy to Approve Financial Report given by Nick, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Nathan; Coy Yes Nathan Yes Chad Yes
- 4. Robbye shared Dawson recently went to some training for SPWA and received mileage pay since he drove back and forth. She suggested the town raise the rate to 65.5 cent which is the amount listed on IRS website. Coy shared Dawson did pass the train and also received a pay raise now that he is certified. Motion to Approve Mileage Increase by Coy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Chad; Votes: Coy Yes Nathan Yes Chad Yes
- 5. Councilmen Pay will stay the same \$150.00 per month/meeting attend. Council discussed the Treasurer and Clerk pay. Keeping the regular duties as \$700.00 each per month, but increasing the Pay for their extra duties but \$250.00. The current Treasurer's pay is \$750.00 and the Clerk's pay is \$500.00 per month, which was approved at meeting August 11, 2014. Motion by Coy to Approve a \$250.00 increase for both the Treasurer's and Clerk's extra duties, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad; Votes: COY – YES NATHAN – YES CHAD – YES

- 6. Surplus Town Vehicles Tabled by Coy. Police Chief Matt Hines is going to get estimates for the vehicles' values.
- 7. The Ambulance Building is 100% completed now. Town and EMT is working on internet since the company put a password on it, but they are working on getting that fixed so they can have access. Town plans to move the current pager system to building, but there as been a new one ordered as well that will stay with EMT so the current one can be returned to the police training center. No Action Needed.
- 8. CN Assistance Request. No Updates. Tabled by Coy.
- 9. Condemnation. No updates. Tabled by Coy.
- 10. Matt read Police Financial Report. Police dept. still has an open spot. Collection system has been updated and improving. New Units have been outfitted and are in use. The T Horns requested for J street have been installed. Matt as been requested by FBI on the Smith Case, so he will be working on that in the coming weeks. Matt has requested a quote for printers, ink, services etc. from Miller Office in McAlester so the town can have a central printer and save on costs. Motion by Coy to Approve the Police Report and Accept the Miller Office Quote base on Matt Hine's Approval, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chad; Votes: Coy Yes Chad Yes Nathan Yes
- 11. Fire Chief Jeff Jones shared Dept is doing good. Truck (2013 F150) that is donated will be ready soon just waiting to get decals added. Jeff will register for the SoonerWarn. No Action Needed
- 12. New Business; Town Attorney Russell is wanting to get insurance and he was setup for insurance, but Town Clerk provided Minutes from previous meeting showing council approved a \$200.00 pay raise instead of insurance. Council with the guidance of the town attorney agreed to keep that the same, so if he gets insurance Russell will have to pay the full amount of the insurance and his rate for the town will remain the same. Council asked that the Town Attorney's Pay be added to the agenda next month and bring Town Ordinance for Town Attorney as well. No Action Needed.
